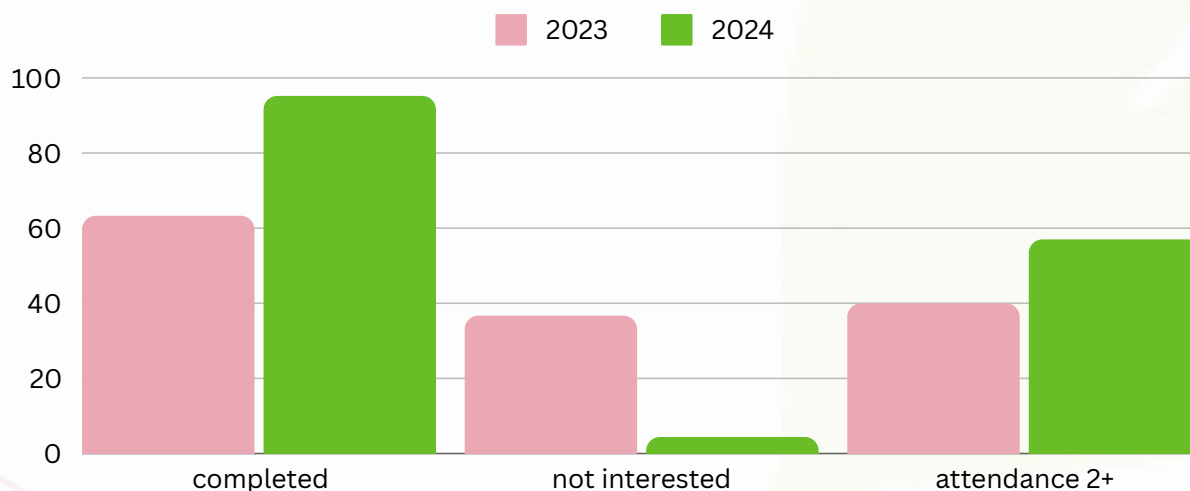
Community Wellness Events

Wellness Assessment Navigation Tool



A study conducted by McGill University concluded that our participants greatly appreciate the Wellness Assessment Navigation Tool. This tool helps assess the needs of new registrants and recommends suitable programs, ensuring a tailored experience for each individual.

- Increase in completing the assessment: From 63.3% to 95.2%
- Lower rate of refusing to be assessed: From 36.7% to 4.4%
- Increase in participants returning more than twice: From 40% to 57%

Increased Form Completion: The implementation of the Wellness Assessment Navigation Tool has led to a significant increase in the number of participants completing the Tool. This indicates that more participants are engaged and willing to provide the necessary information, which helps in tailoring the wellness programs to their needs.

Decrease in Refusals: Refusals have dropped, suggesting the tool is user-friendly and participants feel more comfortable providing their information.

Higher Attendance Rates: The tool has also positively impacted attendance rates at the Centre, with participants attending more than twice increasing from 40% to 57%. This indicates that the tool boosts both initial and continued involvement in our wellness programs.

7 Pillars of Wellness



Cancer wellness is defined as a whole-person approach to support living well with cancer, at any stage of the cancer trajectory of care. Each person living with cancer is guided to address all their needs within all seven pillars.



Physical

Physical needs, including physical comfort, physio oncology evaluation, pain relief, symptom management, nutrition, and activities.



Emotional

Emotional needs, encompassing emotional wellbeing, counseling, sound healing meditation, and energy programs.



Spiritual

Spiritual needs, which involve fostering hope, a sense of belonging, and finding meaning and purpose in life, along with activities such as Tai Chi, journaling, and assorted workshops.



Social

Social needs, including interests such as photography and oil painting, family relationships, community involvement, and connecting with others in diverse support groups.



Informational

Informational needs, encompassing access to resources, referrals to external organizations for services at home, guidance on what to expect in cancer care, palliative care, or end-of-life situations, and information on various relevant topics.



Practical

Practical needs, such as specialized occupational therapy for oncology evaluation to aid in daily living, including homemaking services and financial assistance.



Systemic

Systemic needs, such as navigating systems like the medical system.

Outreach Efforts

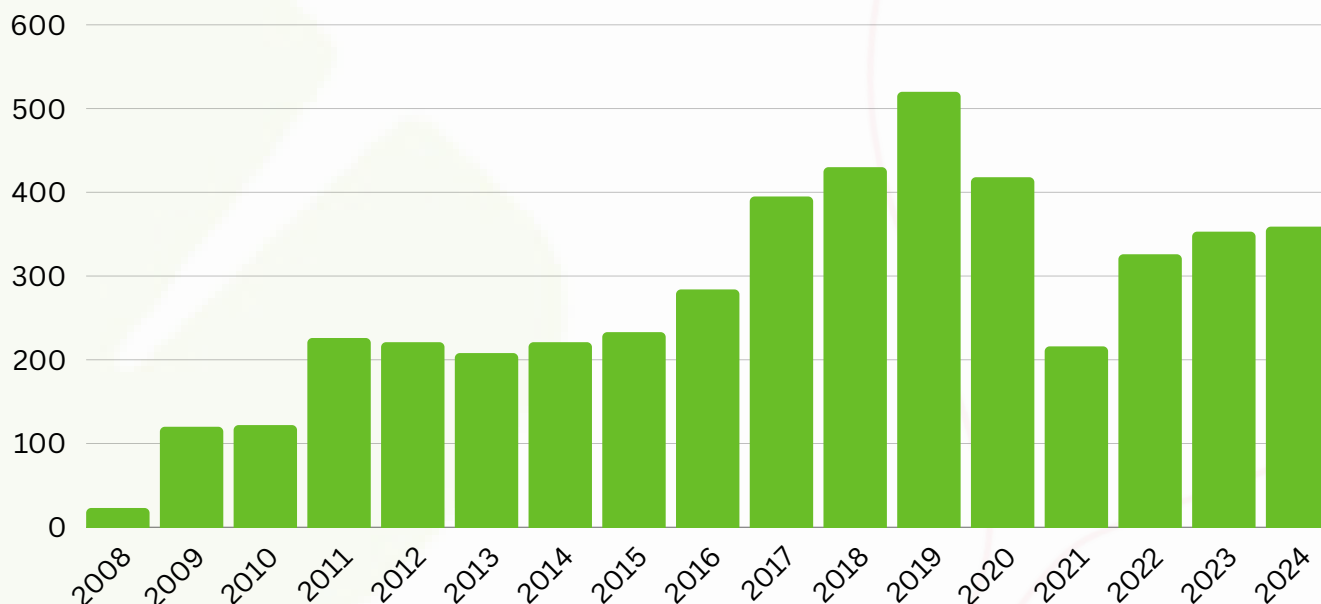
Our outreach efforts aim to raise significant awareness of our services. Through various strategies, we've connected with the local community and oncology professionals, strengthening relationships and improving referrals to our Centre.



Key initiatives include:

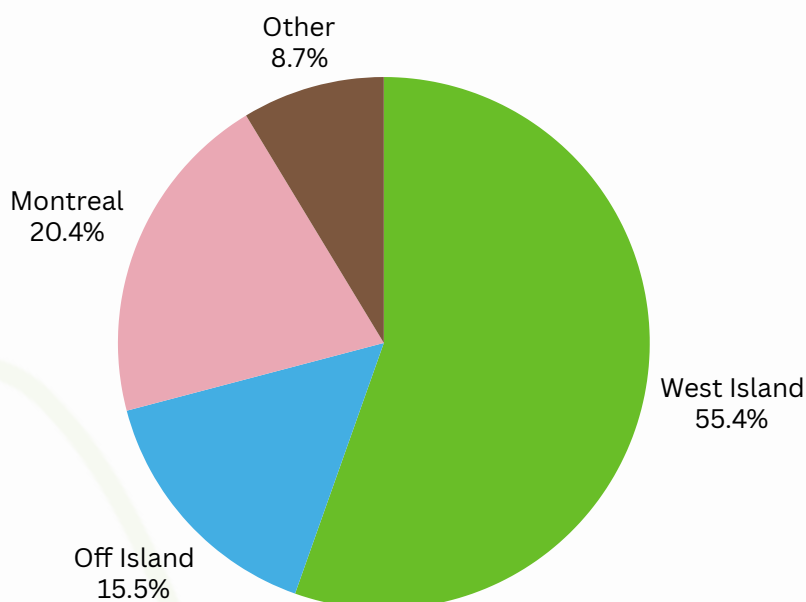
- **New quarterly newsletter:** In addition to the one sent to participants and pivot nurses, this newsletter focuses on cancer wellness, aligning our services with current research and offering referral information.
- **Ambassadors' group:** Members attend community fairs (e.g., John Rennie High School) and deliver WICWC promotional packages to organizations, schools, and hospitals following meetings with Stacey.
- **French hospital connections:** We've begun building relationships with CHUM and Maisonneuve-Rosemont hospitals.
- **Oncology professionals:** Stacey and Debbie have met with professionals from various organizations and hospitals, focusing on the Adolescent and Young Adult (AYA) population.
- **Surgeon presentations:** We informed about 20 surgeons at Lakeshore of WICWC's essential role and how they can support our mission.

Registrations



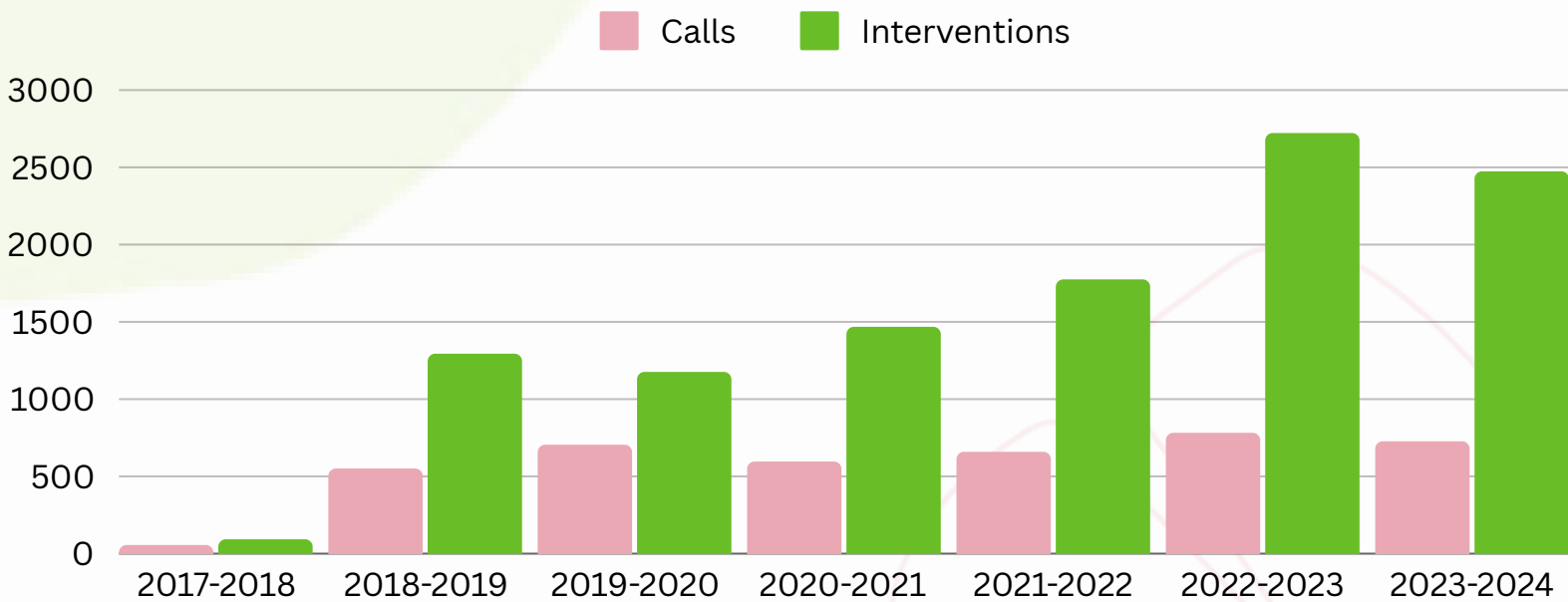
Since 2021, we've observed a positive trend in registering new participants, with numbers steadily increasing each year. In 2024, we saw a modest increase in registrations, signalling a steady, positive trend as we continue to recover from the challenges of previous years. This reflects growing comfort within our community, a trend we anticipate will continue.

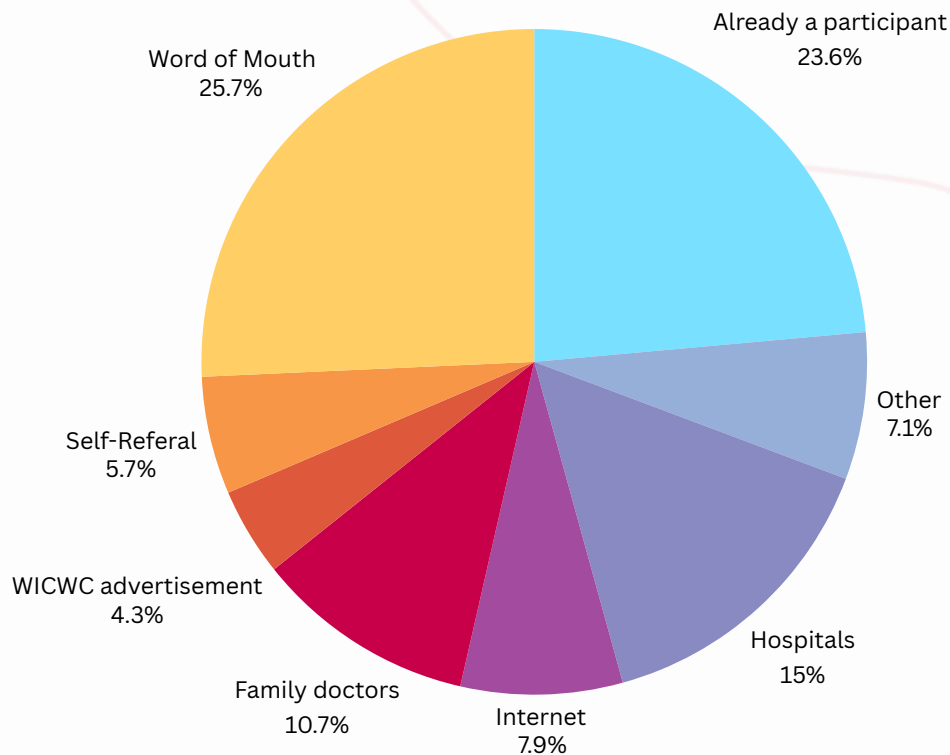
LWWCN: Calls & Interventions



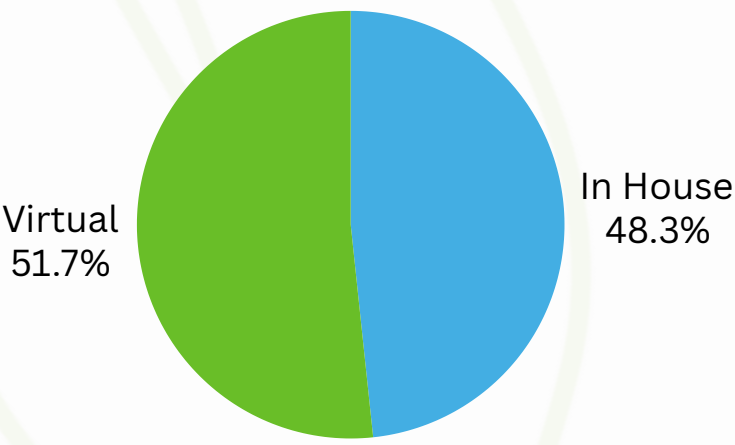
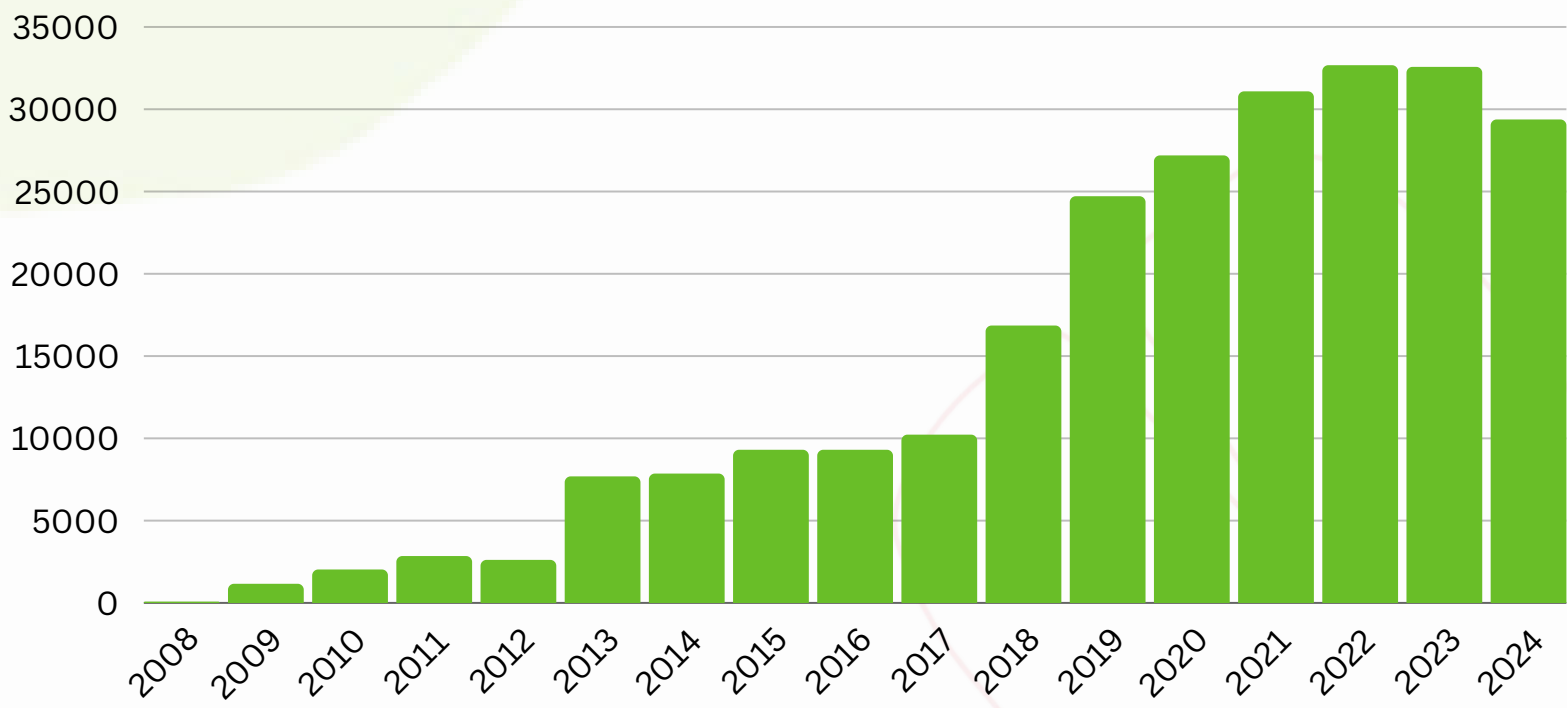
Referral Source

Programming Hours



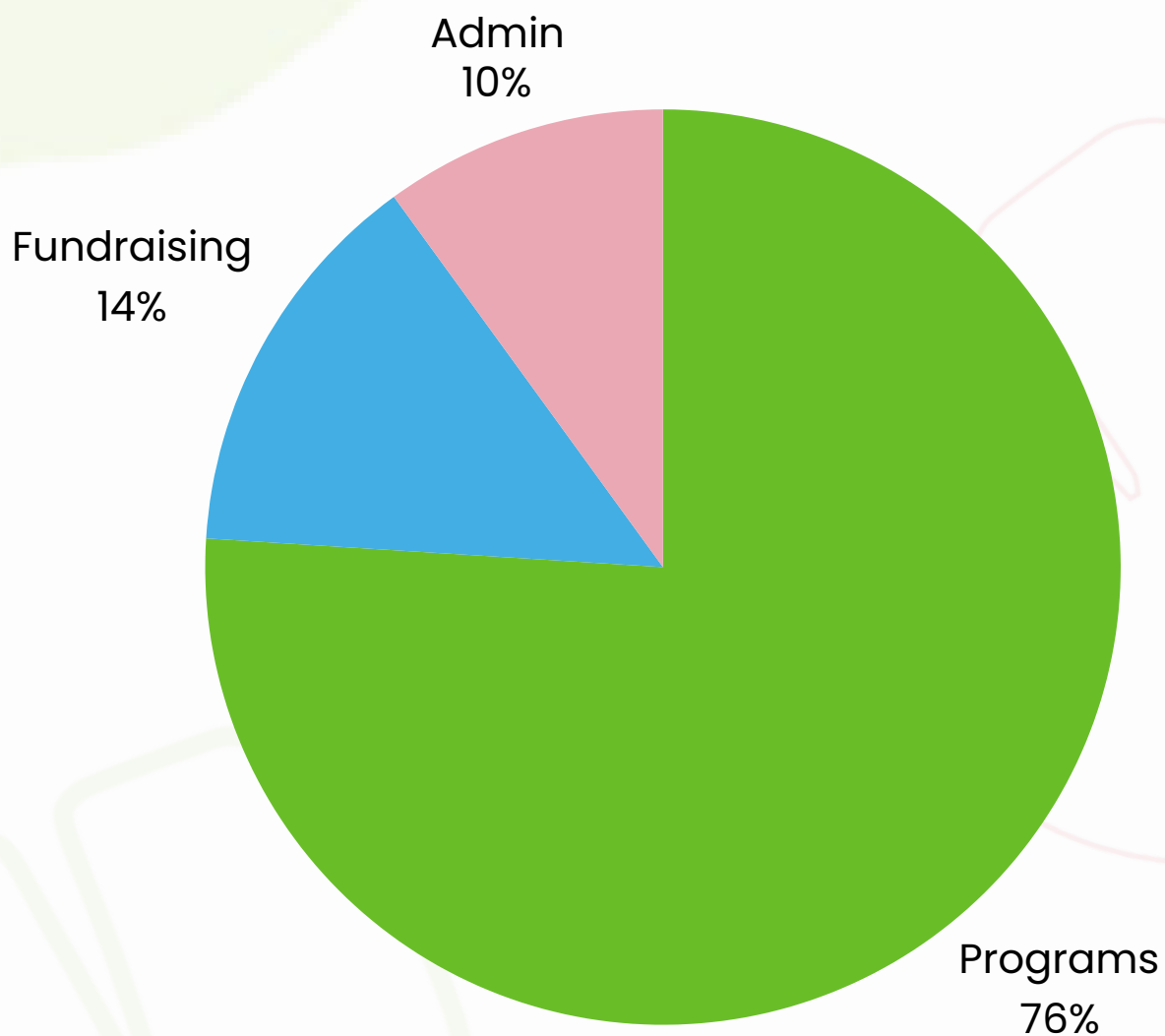
The total hours decreased in 2024 as our regular Zoom into Wellness sessions were not included this year. However, there was a higher percentage of in-house participation compared to last year.
